20	WHEREAS, SFCC defines "Banner" as "a temporary sign no larger than eighteen (18)		
21	square feet made of flexible material (cloth, paper, vinyl, or other lightweight, non-rigid material)		
22	on which information relating to an event, function, or activity is painted or printed, which projects		
23	from, hangs from, or is affixed to a city-owned support structure"; and		
24	WHEREAS, a resolution approving the installation of banners must specify dates of

WHEREAS, Resolution No. 2019-23 approved the design and installation for 20 banners ommemorating the lives of those local veterans who are serving, have served, or have been

WHEREAS, Resolution No. 2019-37 approved 30 additional banners for the same urpose; and

WHEREAS, Resolution No. 2020-14 approved as many banners as there are light poles long Cerrillos Road between I-25 and Rodeo Road; and

WHEREAS, Resolution No. 2022-9 expanded the display of the banners on sign support tructures, installed along Cerrillos Road between I-25 and St. Michael's Drive; and

WHEREAS, in 2022, the City improved its infrastructure by purchasing and installing pring-loaded brackets on Cerrillos Road and, in Resolution 2022-44, the Governing Body pproved the installation of Hometown Heroes banners by the American Legion on all of the Cerrillos Road Corridor, St. Francis Drive, the Railyard, Guadalupe Street, and the Greater Downtown Area; and

WHEREAS, in Resolution 2023-25, the Governing Body approved the displaying the banners on light poles along St. Francis Drive from I-25 to Alamo Drive; and Cerrillos Road from I-25 to St. Francis Drive; and

WHEREAS, the American Legion has transferred the Hometown Heroes banners to the Knights of Columbus Council 10517 ("Knights of Columbus") and the Knights of Columbus wishes to continue displaying banners celebrating Santa Fe veterans with an updated program called "Santa Fe Heroes"; and

WHEREAS, the Knights of Columbus seeks permission to place the banners during May, in advance of Memorial Day, through Veterans Day, during 2024 and 2025; and

WHEREAS, the Governing Body desires to allow the Knights of Columbus to install the

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF SANTA FE that the design and installation plan for banners celebrating Santa Fe

> The Santa Fe Knights of Columbus may display the banners every year, between Memorial Day and Veterans Day, with installation of the banners occurring as early as the week before Memorial Day and removal occurring up to the week after Veterans Day.

> The banners may be displayed on light poles located along St. Francis Drive; Guadalupe Road from Paseo de Peralta to St. Francis Drive; and Cerrillos Road from I-25 to St.

A maximum of one banner per light pole.

The Land Use Director and City Attorney have approved the design of the banners as conforming to all applicable requirements and restrictions. If the design ever changes, or if the City's design standards ever change, renewed review and approval by the Land Use Director and City Attorney's Office is required to ensure conformance with

The Knights of Columbus is responsible for the installation of the banners associated with this request, including obtaining the obstruction permits required for installation and removal of the banners pursuant to
